## **The Scholarship Criteria**

- Offered to incoming freshmen only.
- Applicant must be a minority as defined below:
  1. Black Americans, including all persons having origins in any of the Black African racial groups not of Hispanic origin
  2. Hispanic Americans, including all persons or Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish Culture or origin, regardless of race
  3. All persons having origins in the Iberian Peninsula, including Portugal, regardless of race
  4. Women
  5. Asian Pacific Americans and Pacific islanders; or
  6. American Indians and persons having origins in any or the original peoples of North America and maintaining identifiable tribal affiliations through membership and participation or community identification
- Applicant must demonstrate a commitment to academic success
- Applicant must be accepted into an accredited four-year college or university
- Applicant must plan on attending college full-time

## **Scholarship Disbursement**

- The scholarship is currently a one-time financial award of \$2,500.
- Distributions will be made directly to the awardee to be used toward tuition or educational materials.
