The Scholarship Criteria

- Offered to incoming freshmen only.
- Applicant must be a minority as defined below:
 - 1. Black Americans, including all persons having origins in any of the Black African racial groups not of Hispanic origin.
 - 2. Hispanic Americans, including all persons or Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish Culture or origin, regardless of race.
 - 3. All persons having origins in the Iberian Peninsula, including Portugal, regardless of race.
 - 4. Women.
 - 5. Asian Pacific Americans and Pacific islanders; or
 - 6. American Indians and persons having origins in any or the original peoples of North America and maintaining identifiable tribal affiliations through membership and participation or community identification.
- Applicant must demonstrate a commitment to academic success.
- Applicants must be accepted into an accredited four-year college or university.
- Applicants must plan on attending college full-time.

Scholarship Disbursement

- The scholarship is currently a one-time financial award of \$2,500.
- Distributions will be made directly to the awardee to be used toward tuition or educational materials.
